Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Hasedera Temple



This temple is said to be one of the largest wooden structure in Japan and the grounds are particularly beautiful in early summer when the hydrangea are in bloom or when the leaves are changing in the autumn. There is a panoramic view looking down on the sea from the observatory platform.

Zuisenji Temple



Popular as the 'Temple of Flowers' and famous for daffodils and plum blossom in the winter and early spring as well as the changing autumn leaves. The stone garden behind the Buddhist sanctum also has a certain charm.
