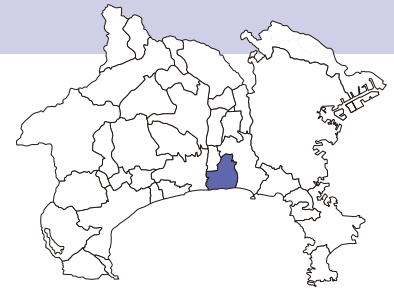

Tourist Attraction

Chigasaki is on the way from Tokyo and Yokohama to Hakone and Odawara. This quiet coastal town is sister cities with Honolulu, Hawaii and possesses truly magnificent scenery. The very popular Eboshi Rock Cruise departs from Chigasaki Fishing Port, cruises round the Eboshi Rock allowing passengers to see the other side of the rock that are not usually visible, Enoshima from the sea and, if it is a clear day, the World Heritage Site, Mt. Fuji.

Hamaori Festival



Revered as a shrine that has enshrined several gods in Chigasaki in Sagami Province since ancient times, it was the first clan shrine that Genji built. It is called the main shrine with respect to Kamakura Tsuruoka Shrine which is called the original shrine and is an ancient shrine used to pray for the retreat of the Mongolians. The lively Hamaori Festival or Akatsuki no Saiten consists of "misogi" in which many portable shrines are taken into the sea in the early morning of Marine Day in July each year.
