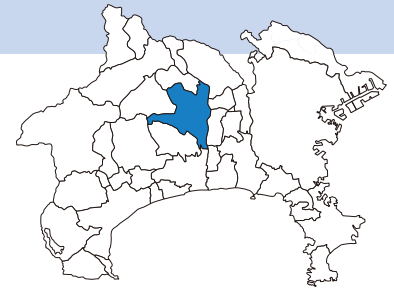

Hiking along Mount Haku's Junrei Pass

Explanation of
Tourist Attraction

A hiking course where you can experience nature and history at Iiyama Hakusan Nature Park. Mount Haku has an altitude of 284 meters, and you can enjoy the magnificent view from the summit observatory. Nearby is Hakusan Shrine and Hakusan Lake, the latter of which never runs dry and has become a legend because of this. Also nearby is Iiyama Kannon, a place to visit that was selected as one of the 50 Best Views in Kanagawa.

Many seasonal events are held here, including the New Year Fukumukae ("Fortune-Bringing") Festival, the Plum Festival in Spring, the Chinese Lantern Plant Market and the Morning Glory Market in Summer. There is a fresh water spring, known as Sennen no Mori no Mizu ("Waters of the 1,000-year forest"), on the shrine grounds. In Summer, fireflies come to the area and create a fantastic sight.

Lake Miyagase's Mizunosato Suspension Bridge



A large 315-meter long suspension bridge for pedestrian use only. Walking along this bridge give you the sense that you're walking along the surface of Lake Miyagase. During the Christmas season, the bridge is decorated with 300,000 LED lights and a tunnel of lights is created.
