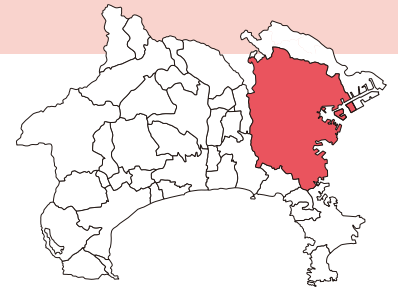

Yokohama Noh Theatre



Explanation of Tourist Attraction

Yokohama Noh Theater is located on high ground within a 10 minute drive from Yokohama China Town, the Minato Mirai District, and the Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse. The historic 140 year-old main stage was originally built in 1875 as the Somei Noh Stage before being relocated and restored . The stage is an extremely important part of both architectural history and the history of Noh theater, and it was designated as a Yokohama cultural heritage.

Services/Activities

Guided tours featuring various hands-on activities and explanations of Noh theater, a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage, are available (Explanations are provided in Japanese only. Tours must be accompanied by an interpreter / tour guide. The cost of a tour is ¥14,000. Reservations are required.). Guests who wish to stand on the stage must purchase white tabi socks (¥2,060).

Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Kamonyama Park (Cherry Blossoms)



Located on elevated land that looks out over Yokohama Minato Mirai 21, this park houses a bronze statue of Naosuke Ii. It is famous for its cherry blossom and it is crowded with visitors during the blossom season.

Minato Mirai District



A new town created through the redevelopment of the industrial district around Yokohama Port. Popular spots include Landmark Tower, large hotels and Yokohama Museum of Art.
