Explanation of Tourist Attraction

The oldest art museum in Hakone. Founder Mokichi Okada opened the museum based on his conviction that "art should never be owned by individuals, but should be shown to as many people as possible to improve their character and contribute to the development of culture." Okada also purchased a country villa area and a Japanese garden that was part of the Gora Park, and the Shinsenkyo he reconstructed on the site was designated as a Registered National Monument owing to it being highly acclaimed as a historical and cultural legacy. The estate includes a Moss Garden containing approximately 130 species of moss and 200 maple trees, a Bush Clover Path that is best seen in September, a Bamboo Garden that resembles a Chinese garden, and other features that can be enjoyed throughout all seasons.
