




The beauty of nature delights the senses

Tsukuiko (Lake Tsukui) Area

Kanagawa Prefectural Tsukuiko-Shiroyama Park is near Shiroyama Dam (Lake Tsukui) and the Shiroyama mountain castle ruins. Mizo-no-Enchi garden (North) and the Hana-no-Enchi garden (South) and Mt. Shiroyama are superb cherry blossom spots.

Shiroyamako (Lake Shiroyama) Area

Serene, emerald green Lake Shiroyama is the perfect spot for nature walks. Enjoy seasonally-blooming trees and flowers: Japanese Dogtooth Violet in late March, and Cosmos and colorful foliage in autumn.

From mid July through late August, about 550,000 sunflowers bloom at the largest scale around Tokyo. Blooming times differ by area, so by changing location you can see them at their best.

Sagami Area: History and Culture

Ogura Bridge

This beautiful arch bridge, built in 1938, is a registered tangible cultural property of Sagamihara City, and also noted among: 50 Kanagawa Scenic Sites, 100 Kanagawa Bridges, and 8 Sagami Picturesque Sites. The bridge is lit up and lanterns are set aloft on the river in summer.

Old Seiryuji Temple Historical Residence (old 'Minka-en' House Garden)

An Edo Period thatch-roofed house at Sagamiyama Nature Village Park. Former temple quarters were moved to location from Kami-Tsuruma.

Shokokuji Temple

It's known as 'Haiku' (Japanese poetry) temple since there are numerous stones with famous haiku poets inscribed on them. It's one of the sites on the Tsukui Kannon pilgrimage. The garden is resplendent with Azaleas and Camellias. The next public exposition will be held in 2020.

Old 'Minka' Folk House: Kishi House

Constructed around 1891, this structure in the spacious 1,716 m² area is representative of homes of the Meiji Period. It's a tangible cultural property of Atsugi City.

Shimo-Tsuruma Furusato Kan (Old 'Minka' Ogura House)

The old Ogura house of Yamato city designation important cultural property has a restored main structure and warehouse, built in 1856, is one of the few remaining traditional merchant homes in the Kanagawa prefecture.

Sagami Kokubunji Ato (Historic site)

Sagami Kokubunji Ato is a historic park popular with locals and visitors alike. Ebina Chuo Park has a 1:3 scale model of a 7-story pagoda.

Shokokuji Temple

Sacred site number 8 of the 33 Bando Kannon pilgrimage, this temple has a unique one-hammer 'Bonsho' temple bell (a national important cultural property). Local folklore has it that stars are reflected in the wishing well, even during the daytime.

Kanzaki Iseki Shiryō-kan (Kanzaki Ruins Museum)

The first historical museum in Ayase, opened in May, 2016, introduces local history and culture, including Kanzaki Iseki (Yayoi Period ruins), a national historic site.

Obarajuku Honjin

A lodging for 'Daimyo', feudal lords, on their way to the capital, Edo, it's the only one remaining on the Tokai-do and Koshu-Kaido Roads in Kanagawa Prefecture. It's an important prefectural cultural heritage site. The spacious, traditional Japanese building is embellished with the family crest.

Historic Site Tana Mukaihara Remains Paleolithic Study Center (Paleolithic HATENA House)

A Paleolithic Period site, Tanamukaihara ruins is a national historic site. In the park at the site, artifacts from the Paleolithic Period, restored pit-dwellings from the Jomon Period, and burial mounds from the Kofun (Tumulus) Period, are on display.

Iiyama Kannon (Kannon at Chokokuji Temple)

This temple is well known as the 6th sacred place on the 33 Bando Kannon pilgrimage. Kannon-do Hall is designated as tangible cultural property of Atsugi city. There is the legendary 'dosho' (copper bell) that is designated an important cultural property of Kanagawa prefecture in this temple. The roofstyle of Hondō is called 'hogyō-zukuri'. The roof, made by copper sheet (soban-buki), and all the roof edges are gathered at the center. It is famous as a temple of matchmaking as well as being popular for its cherry blossoms.

Yamato-shi Kyodo Minka-en (Old 'Minka' Folk House Museum)

These two restored folk houses and spacious 3,900m² garden are inside Izumi no Mori Park, the fountainhead of Hikichi River. It's an important cultural property of Yamato City.
