Sankeien Garden was opened in 1906 by Sankei Hara, a multi-talented Silk Trade entrepreneur and altruist with a deep appreciation for Japanese culture and heritage. As well as being one of the finest examples of the iconic Japanese garden aesthetic, it also showcases historical buildings meticulously relocated from all over Japan. They include a 400 year old Samurai Teahouse, which can be reserved for guests to experience a private tea ceremony. There is also an exclusive tour by the garden's curator of the "Rinshunkaku". This was used as a residential villa for samurai leaders in the mid-17th century, and displays the most spectacular architecture, art and ornaments of the era.
