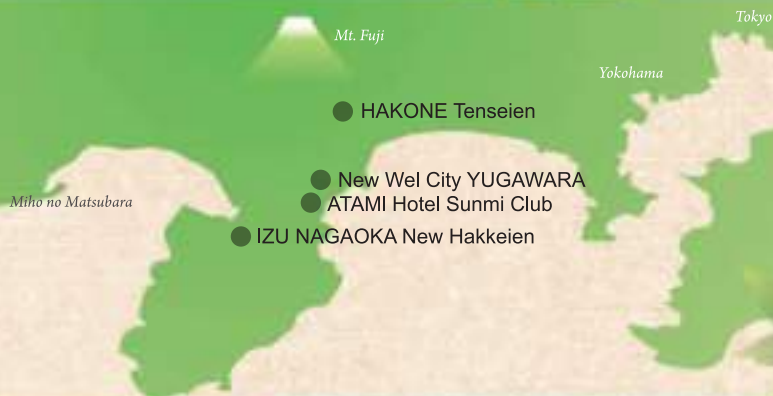

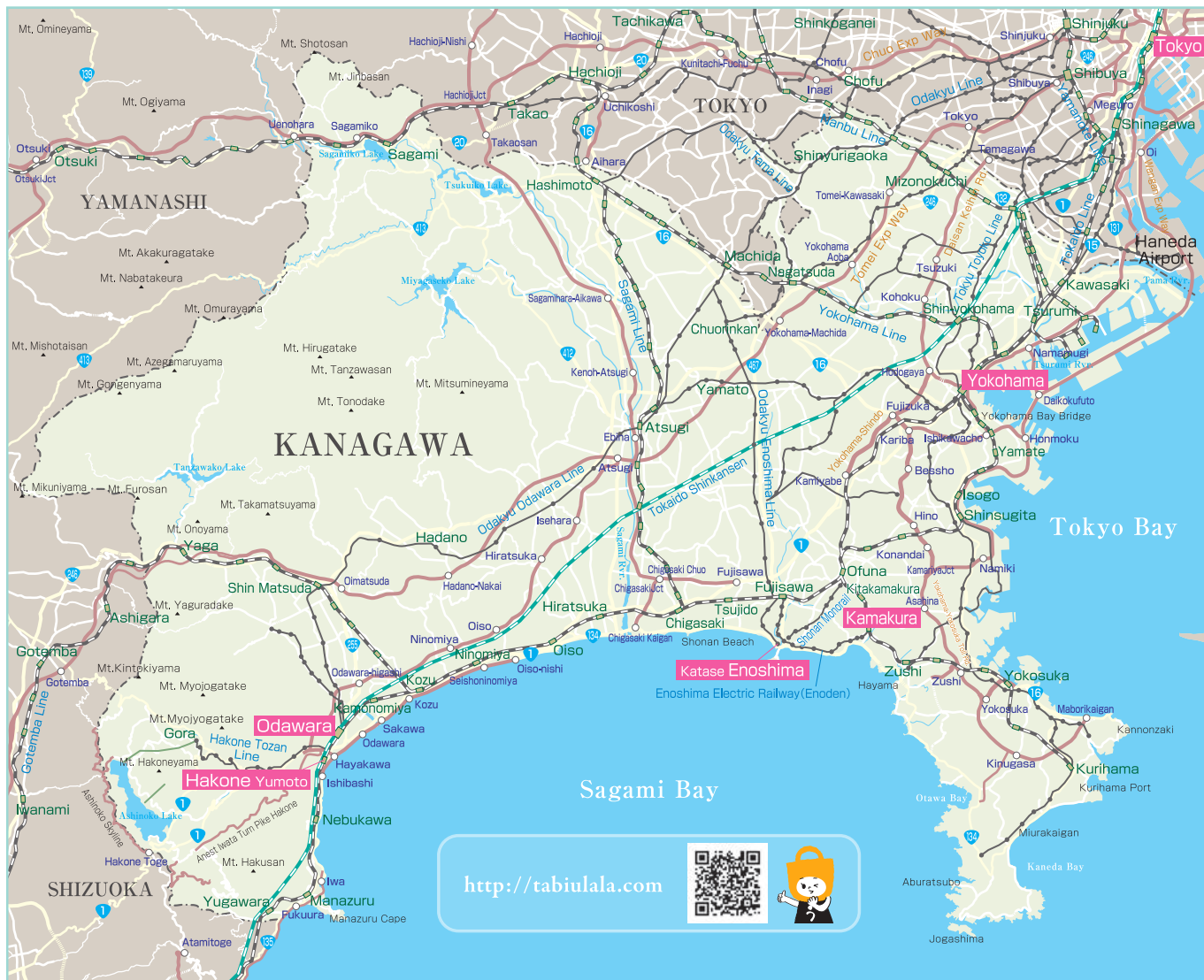

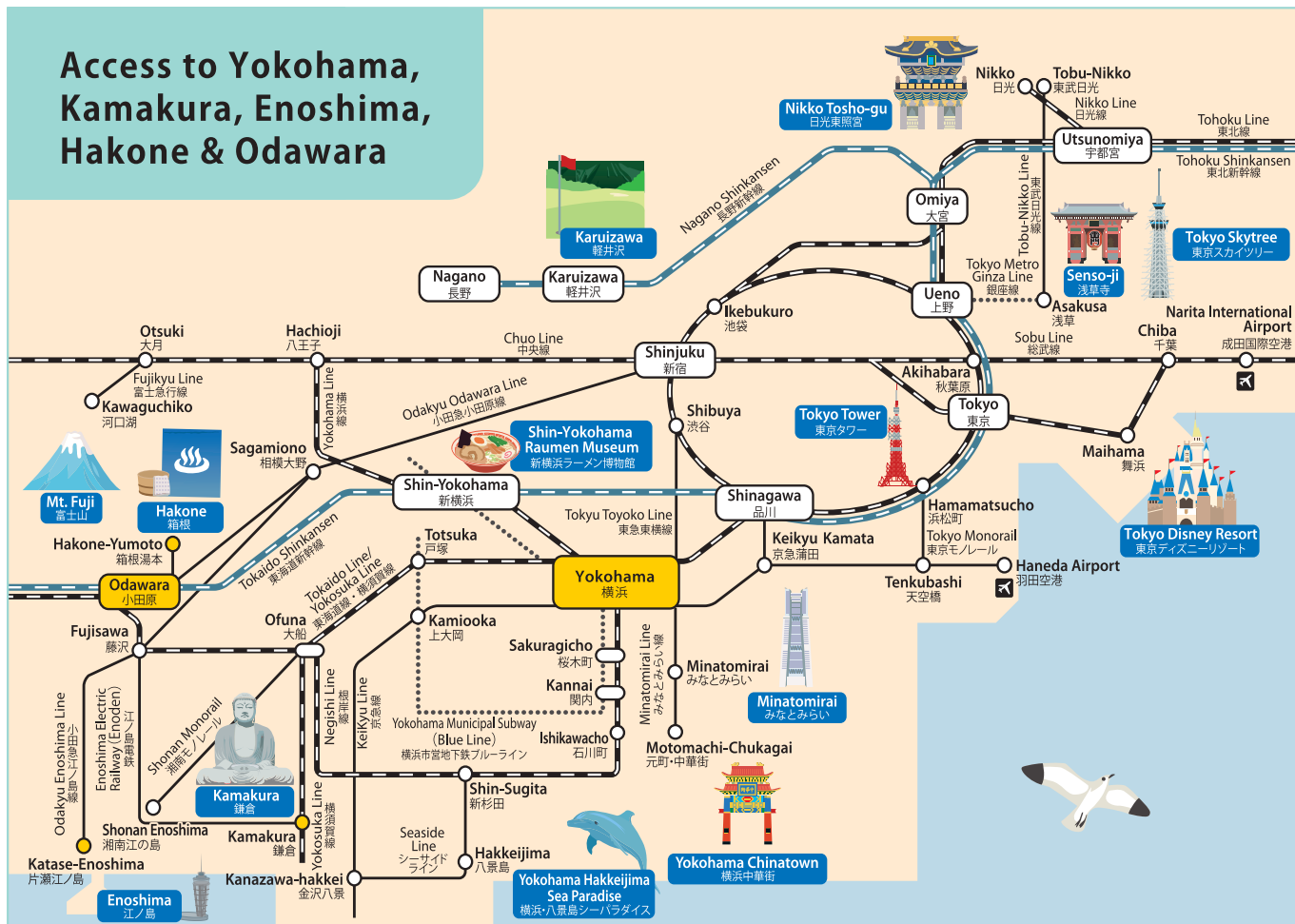

01. Lake Ashi 芦ノ湖 (MAP P40 B-5)

Enjoy pleasure cruise, boats, etc. at the lake! There are also a shrine, museums, and amusement spots.

02. Owakudani Valley 大涌谷 (MAP P40 C-3)

The crater area is filled with smokes & smell of sulfur. It's also famous as a viewpoint of Mt. Fuji.

03. Odawara Castle 小田原城 (MAP P41 G-5)

Documents are exhibited in the castle building. The park is also attractive to enjoy the nature.

04. Kamaboko (steamed seasoned fish paste) かまぼこ

Odawara's local specialties. They are made by seasoning, forming & cooking white fish.

05. Hakone Komagatake Ropeway 箱根 駒ヶ岳ロープウェイ (MAP P40 B-4 ~ C-4)

06. Hakone Ropeway 箱根ロープウェイ (MAP P40 A-3 ~ C-3)

Get close to Mt. Fuji & Lake Ashi by ropeway.

07. Hotspots (Onsen) 温泉

There are various kinds and types of onsen. You can find different efficacies.

08. Ryokan (Japanese-style inn) 旅館

Ryokan, Japanese-style inn, established in unique Japanese culture. You can experience *omotenashi* fine services there.

▼ Smoking Restriction Signs ▼



Kanagawa Prefecture has set the smoking rules to prevent exposure to secondhand smoke in public spaces such as restaurants and hotels. The ordinance requires those facilities to choose whether to become nonsmoking or offer separate smoking areas.

- At restaurants, guests are required to check those smoking restriction signs displayed and to follow the smoking rules.
- Minors under 20 years old are prohibited to enter the smoking sections/areas.
- Effective April 1, 2020, as a general rule, indoor smoking will be prohibited at many public facilities such as cafes and restaurants. (A smoking room can be set up.)

09. Motomachi 元町 (MAP P23 G-3)

The street is lined up with many well-established brand shops of "Hama Tra" (Yokohama Traditional Fashion), as well as other shops of clothing, furniture, jewelry and restaurants.

10. Noge 野毛 (MAP P22 D-4)

Yokohama's biggest eating area with some 500 restaurants & bars. The area boasts its history and deep attractiveness.

11. Chinese steamed bun 肉まん

The town is ideal for trying various restaurants. Why don't you have your meal there?

12. Yokohama China Town 横浜中華街 (MAP P23 G-3)

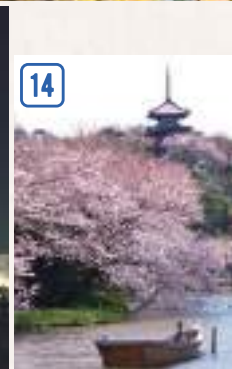
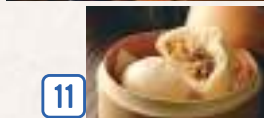
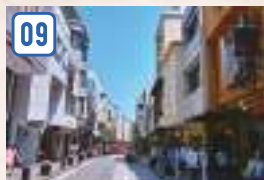
One of the largest china towns in the world. You can taste fine Chinese foods at the gourmet town filled with colors and energy.

18. Young sardines of Shonan しらす

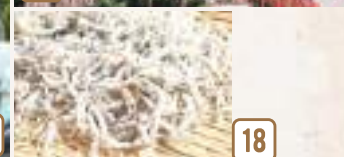
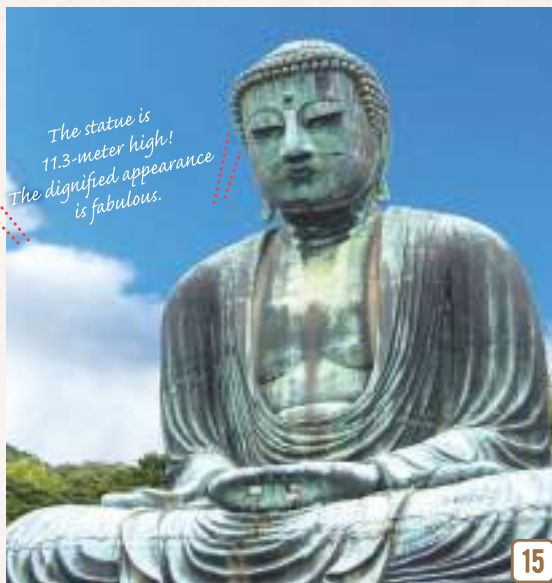
Young sardines are main local specialty. You can taste the raw sardines if you visit the area during the season!

Zazen is one of Buddhist practices of seated meditation in a cross-legged position. Let's try it.

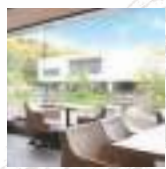
20. Enoden (Enoshima Electric Railways) 江ノ電

Tsurugaoka Hachimangu

鶴岡八幡宮

One of the historic sites that represent Kamakura. The vermillion lacquer, the green of the hills, and the blue sky by the shrine pavilion are a beautiful sight seen from Wakamiya-Oji Street, which stretches all the way to the ocean.

O-ichou Ema ¥1,000

Great-Ginkgo Votive Tablet; this ema is in the shape of the leaves of the Great Ginkgo, which unfortunately was toppled in a windstorm in 2010.

This ema shows two different aspects of the Great-Ginkgo; one is with fresh green leaves in the early summer, and the other is with yellow leaves in the autumn.

Hasedera Temple

長谷寺

According to legend, in 721 AD the pious monk Tokudo Shonin discovered a large camphor tree in the mountain forests near the village of Hase in the Nara region. He realized that the trunk of the tree was large enough to provide sufficient material for carving two statues of the eleven-headed Kannon. The statue he commissioned to be carved from the lower part of the trunk was enshrined in Hasedera Temple near Nara; the statue from the upper half (actually the larger of the two) was thrown into the sea with a prayer that it would reappear to save the people. Fifteen years later, in 736 on the night of June 18, it washed ashore at Nagai Beach on the Miura Peninsula not far from Kamakura, sending out rays of light as it did. The statue was then brought to Kamakura and a temple was constructed to honor it. Since time immemorial, Hasedera Temple has been known as the 4th station among the 33 holy places in the Kanto area.

Kamakurabori (Kamakura Carving)

鎌倉彫

Kamakurabori is a style of carved lacquerware and a specialty of Kamakura City, that is crafted by carving wood, applying black lacquer, and then applying colored lacquer such as vermillion, blue, or yellow on top. Originally used to make articles for Buddhist rituals, this artform has been passed down for over 800 years. In the Kamakurabori Museum, where about 50 classic and contemporary works of kamakurabori are displayed, a video showing the process of making kamakurabori is played continuously, and a workshop where you can try your hand at kamakurabori carving is also held. On the first floor, there is a gift shop/cafe/gallery where you can enjoy the charm of kamakurabori in the relaxing atmosphere. Please contact for inquiry and apply for the workshop by e-mail.

Kotoku-in Temple (Great Buddha "Daibutsu")

鎌倉大仏殿高德院

The statue commonly known as Kamakura Daibutsu (Great Buddha of Kamakura), a colossal copper image of Amida-butsu (Amitabha Buddha), is the principle image of Kotoku-in. The fact that it sits in the open air makes it unusual amongst large Buddha statues in Japan. The Great Buddha, designated as a National Treasure by the Japanese government, is about 11.3 meters tall and weighs around 121 tons. Though in size it falls short of the Great Buddha of Todai-ji Temple at Nara (an image of Rushana-butsu [Vairocana Buddha]), it essentially retains its original form; as such it is an invaluable example of Japanese historical Buddhist art. Today, 750 years after its construction, vast numbers of Buddhists of all sects from around the world and Japan come to pay their respects to the Great Buddha.

This Zen Buddhist temple is the head temple of the Kencho sect of the Rinza school. It was founded in the year 1253 by Tokiyori Hojo. The temple is dedicated to the bodhisattva Jizo (Kshitigarbha). The grounds are designated as a national historic site under the name "Kenchoji Keidai". With cherry blossoms, hydrangea, autumn leaves, and so on, the natural colors of each season here are charming. In addition, it is connected to the Tenen hiking course from the priests' temple quarters in the inner part of the site.

Minamoto Yoritomo, the founder of the Kamakura government, ordered the shrine's construction after a god appeared in his dream and recommended him to build the shrine in order to bring peace to the country. Because the dream occurred on the day of the snake, in the month of the snake of the year of the snake, the shrine was later also dedicated to Bentei, a Buddhist goddess associated with snakes.

Odawara Castle

小田原城

Odawara Castle is probably the best example of a castle to visit in the immediate Tokyo area. The museum in the main keep has a nice collection of artifacts, armor, and weapons. They have also done a great job reconstructing some gates and maintaining the castle grounds. This castle was the family residence of feudal lord Hojo. You can retrace the mighty steps of feudal lords in this elegant place which has come through the Edo age to the present day. Take a step back in time with feudal costumes - at the Tokiwagi gate of the castle, you can hire (for a fee) samurai armour and kimono and have your photograph taken wearing the outfit, with the castle in the background. It will be a wonderful souvenir of your visit.

Amongst these seventeen, seven have particularly long traditions. These seven are, Yumoto, Tonosawa, Miyanoshita, Dogashima, Sokokura, Kiga, and Ashinoyu.

Made in Odawara: The Local Specialty Products of Odawara

小田原の特産品

Odawara, where the ocean and mountains meet in mild climate, has many local specialties. From the ocean, fish meat is ground and steamed to produce "kamaboko" (fish cake), and whole fish are sun-dried to make "himono". From the mountains, orange and lemon crops are grown, and plums are pickled to make their famous umeboshi. Since they have prospered as a post station and castle town from long ago, you can still see traditional techniques in their popular souvenirs, such as "Odawara-chochin" (lantern), "yosegi zaiku" (wood mosaic) and "Odawara-shikki" (lacquerware).

Owakudani Valley

One of the most popular sightseeing spots in Hakone. This area was created during the great collapse of Kami-yama, the highest of the Hakone volcano complex about 3,000 years ago; a phreatic eruption in 2015 created a new crater. Fumarolic gases envelop the desolate ground to this day, and you can feel the intensity of an active volcano. This place is also a popular viewing point for Mt. Fuji.*Due to the volcano activity, you might not be able to enter the area. Hakone Jinja Shrine

箱根神社

Hakone Jinja Shrine is famous for its Shinto shrine archway of Peace, which was founded in its current location in 757 based on a revelation of the priest Mangan. Mangan was a famous priest who trained in strict ascetic practices and pacified the nine-headed dragon that lived at the bottom of Lake Ashi, and his story is still handed down to people today. On the way to the shrine, there is a treasure house where Hakone Gongen Engi Emaki, Mangan Shonin Zazou, historical handwritings, picture scrolls and sculptures that include five items which are ranked as National Important Cultural Property are on exhibit. This shrine is also known as one of Japan's foremost spiritual places.

Tokugawa shogun placed 53 sekisho (facility for inspection) on major roads across the nation to defend Edo (current Tokyo). Hakone Sekisho was one of the largest and was thought to be important among them. Hakone Sekisho was placed on the current location in 1619, during an early period of Edo Era. One of the main roles of sekisho was to control 'incoming guns and outgoing women', which means to prevent weapons from being brought into Edo and wives and children of feudal lords from fleeing from Edo. However, Hakone Sekisho did not inspect 'incoming guns', and severely inspected 'outgoing women'. Sekisho, which operated for about 260 years during Edo Era, was dissolved in the next year of 1868, when the government changed.

Artisans began making these wood works in geometric patterns bringing out the natural colors of wood at Hatajuku of Hakone Mountain in the Late Edo period.
