### Hakone

#### 1 Lake Ashi 声/湖



Lake Ashi is a long-shaped lake with the total length of 19 kilometers. It was formed by caldera of Hakone volcanic mountains about 3,000 years ago. It is also famous for its beautiful view of panoramic Mt. Fuji area. MP18 A-3-C-5




#### Hakone Sightseeing Cruise 箱根海賊船

The pleasure ships with the image of pirate cruise around Lake Ashi. Let's enjoy the lake cruise experiencing seasonal nature. There are three kinds of ships in service.

#### Onsen & Ryokan (Japanese-style inn) 温泉と旅館

#### **2** Hakone Shrine 箱根神社



It was founded by "Manganshonin," a sacred man who was given an oracle from Hakone-no Ookami, the god of Hakone, in 757. Today, the shrine is well known as a power spot as well as the peace-symbol torii gate built near Lake Ashi. In the shrine area, there is a treasure hall which stores national important cultural properties.



Hotoku Ninomiya Shrine 報徳二宮神社 It enshrines famous Sontoku (Kinjiro) Ninomiya and is located in the Odawara Castle area. In the shrine, you can see his statue. Also, there is a restaurant and cafe.

#### 3 Owakudani 大涌谷

Hakone's volcanic crater was made about 3,000 years ago when the mountain had steam explosions. "Kurotamago" black eggs are famous as it is said that your life can extend seven years if you have one.

#### Hakone Ropeway 箱根ロープウェイ



From the ropeway, you can see the great nature, Lake Ashi the smokes in Owakudani area, and Mt. Fuji if it's sunny. The total route is 4 kilometers and it takes about 15 minutes between stations.

#### **5** Hakone Sekisho Exhibition Hall 箱根関所



It is said that Tokugawa shogunate set up the checkpoint for the defense of Edo (currently Tokyo). The checkpoint has been exclusively fully-restored in Japan. Let's visit there and experience the time trip.

### Best viewpoints for Mt.Fuji in Kanagawa

Mt. Fuji is the highest mountain (3,776 meters) in Japan and many people visit there for climbing or sightseeing. We'll introduce superb view spots for Mt. Fuji in Kanagawa. You can see the beautiful silhouette and magnificent scenery from there and take the best shot like a picture postcard.



#### HAKONE P18 B-4~C-4 Mt. Komagatake 駒ヶ岳

About 7 minutes by cable car from Hakone-en which stands by Lake Ashi. From the observatory on the top, you can see the beautiful ridgeline of majestic Mt. Fuji. Don't forget to visit Hakone Mototsumiya which is enshrined in the area. V Motohakone, Hakone-machi 🕴 About 65 min. by bus from Hakane-Yumoto Sta. and get off at
