#### 09. Motomachi 元町(MAP P23 G-3)

The street is lined up with many well-established brand shops of ""Hama Tra"" (Yokohama Traditional Fashion), as well as other shops of clothing, furniture, jewelry and restaurants.

#### **10. Noge 野毛**(MAP P22 D-4)

Yokohama's biggest eating area with some 500 restaurants & bars. The area boasts its history and deep attractiveness.

#### 11. Chinese steamed bun 肉まん

The town is ideal for trying various restaurants. Why don't you have your meal there?

12. Yokohama China Town 横浜中華街(MAP P23 G-3) One of the largest china towns in the world. You can taste fine Chinese foods at the gourmet town filled with colors and energy.

#### **13. Minato Mirai 21** みなとみらい**21** (MAP P22 C-2 , P23 E-2)

The waterfront city conducting development aims to be a "future city of the 21st century". It offers large facilities such as an international conference hall, hotels, and shopping malls.

#### 14. Sankeien Garden 三渓園 (MAP P21 C-3)

This garden was opened to the public as "Sankeien" in 1906 and historical buildings such as Kyoto and Kamakura have been restored.

#### 15. Kotoku-in Temple (Great Buddha "Daibutsu") 鎌倉大仏殿高徳院(MAP P30 A-4)

### **16. Enoshima** 江の島(MAP P31 A-4~B-4)

The famous picturesque scenery where many visitors of Enoshima Shrine have visited. You can walk on the bridge to get there.

#### 17. Tsurugaoka Hachimangu 鶴岡八幡宮 (MAP P30 B-2) The traditional shrine is definitely Kamakura's icon. You can also walk around the grounds to appreciate seasonal trees & flowers.

18. Young sardines of Shonan しらす Young sardines are main local specialty. You can taste the raw sardines if you visit the area during the season!

#### 19. Zazen (Zen meditation) 座禅

Zazen is one of Buddhist practices of seated meditation in a cross-legged position. Let's try it.

20. Enoden(Enoshima Electric Railways) 江/電 The local train which runs on the single track along the coast line. Let's enjoy views from the train windows!



A shopping street centered around streets from 1 Chome to 5 Chome. There is a symbolic arch with a phoenix-shaped sculpture at the entrances on both ends. The street is lined up with many well-established brand shops of ""Hama Tra"" (Yokohama Traditional Fashion), as well as other shops of clothing, variety goods, antiques, cutlery, furniture, jewelry and popular foreign brands, delicious restaurants and fashionable cafes. Benches for resting and watering holes for pets are provided, offering a friendly environment for both humans and pets. Perfect place for a casual stroll. Every year at the end of February and September, a large-scale sale known as "Charming Sale" is held for a week. Many people from all around Japan visit Motomachi for this event. Many stores are closed on Mondays.

# Sail Training Ship NIPPON MARU,


## Noge

Hikawamaru is a cargo and passenger ship constructed in 1930. During World War II, it was used as a government impress ship and a special hospital ship for the navy. It resumed its original role as a Cargo and passenger ship in 1947 and returned to the Seattle Water Route in 1953. It retired in 1960. Visitors can tour the Art Deco-style dining room, the special quest rooms and other rooms, which were renovated based on the resources of the prewar days when the ship navigated on the Seattle Water Route. The stormy history of Hikawamaru is also displayed.



#### Minato Mirai 21 みなとみらい 21

Minato Mirai 21, which means "future port", is a beach shore town in Yokohama. The area is lined with many skyscrapers, including the Landmark Tower which was the tallest building in Japan until 2014, and shopping malls, amusement parks, museums and hot spring facilities, and is bustling with many tourists. Also a popular spot for beautiful nighttime views.

## Tsurugaoka Hachimangu

## Hasedera Temple

According to legend, in 721 AD the pious monk Tokudo Shonin discovered a large camphor tree in the mountain forests near the village of Hase in the Nara region. He realized that the trunk of the tree was large enough to provide sufficient material for carving two statues of the eleven-headed Kannon. The statue he commissioned to be carved from the lower part of the trunk was enshrined in Hasedera Temple near Nara; the statue from the upper half (actually

the larger of the two) was thrown into the sea with a prayer that it would reappear to save the people. Fifteen years later, in 736 on the night of June 18, it washed ashore at Nagai Beach on the Miura Peninsula not far from Kamakura, sending out rays of light as it did. The statue was then brought to Kamakura and a temple was constructed to honor it. Since time immemorial, Hasedera Temple has been known as the 4th station among the 33 holy places in the Kanto area



# Kamakurabori 🕲

Kamakurabori is a style of carved lacquerware and a specialty of Kamakura City, that is crafted by carving wood, applying black lacguer, and then applying colored lacquer such as vermilion, blue, or yellow on top. Originally used to make articles for Buddhist rituals, this artform has been passed down for over 800 years. In the Kamakurabori Museum, where about 50 classic and contemporary works of kamakurabori are displayed, a video showing the process of making kamakurabori is played continuously, and a workshop where you can try your hand at kamakurabori carving is also held. On the first floor, there is a gift shop/cafe/gallery where you can enjoy the Please contact for inquiry and apply for the workshop by e-mail.







#### Enoshima Iwaya Cave 江の島岩屋

This sea cave was formed through centuries of coastal erosion by waves. Since it has been a place of worship from ancient times. there are stories that legendary Buddhist monk Kukai came here for ascetic practice and Shogun Minamoto no Yoritomo visited to pray for victory in battle. They also exhibit stoneworks inside the cave.



Kotoku-in Temple (Great Buddha "Daibutsu") 鎌倉大仏殿高徳院

The statue commonly known as Kamakura Daibutsu (Great Buddha of Kamakura), a colossal copper image of Amida-butsu (Amitabha Buddha), is the principle image of Kotoku-in. The fact that it sits in the open air makes it unusual amongst large Buddha statues in Japan. The Great Buddha, designated as a National Treasure by the Japanese government, is about 11.3 meters tall and weighs around 121 tons. Though in size it falls short of the Great Buddha of Todai-ji Temple at Nara (an image of Rushana-butsu [Vairochana Buddha]), it essentially retains its original form; as such it is an invaluable example of Japanese historical Buddhist art. Today, 750 years after its construction, vast numbers of Buddhists of all sects from around the



#### Kenchoji Temple 巨福山 建長興国禅寺

This Zen Buddhist temple is the head temple of the Kencho sect of the Rinzai school. It was founded in the year 1253 by Tokiyori Hojo. The temple is dedicated to the bodhisattva Jizo (Kshitigarbha). The grounds are designated as a national historic site under the name "Kenchoji Keidai". With cherry blossoms, hydrangea, autumn leaves, and so on, the natural colors of each season here are charming. In addition, it is connected to the Tenen hiking course from the priests' temple quarters in the inner part of the site.



#### Zeniarai Benzaiten Ugafuku Shrine 銭洗弁財天宇賀福神社

Zeniarai Benten Shrine is a popular shrine in Kamakura, which people visit to wash their money (zeniarai means "coin washing"). It is said that money washed in the shrine's spring, doubles. Minamoto Yoritomo the founder of the Kamakura government, ordered the shrine's construction after a god appeared in his dream and recommended him to build the shrine in order to bring peace to the country. Because the dream occurred on the day of the snake, in the month of the snake of the year of the snake, the shrine was later also dedicated to Benten, a Buddhist goddess

#### Enoshima Jinja Shrine 江島神社

Enoshima Jinja Shrine is one of Japan's three great Benzaiten shrines. Enoshima Jinja Shrine consists of three small shrines, each dedicated to a different Shinto goddess. The Hetsu-no-miya shrine is dedicated to Tagitsu-hime-no-mikoto: the Nakatsu-no-miva to hikishima-hime-no-mikoto; and the Okutsu-no-miya to Tagiri-hime-no-mikoto. It gives various blessings including attainment in art, wealth & prosperity, and good marriage-tie, and is popular with many pilgrims.



#### **Enoshima Samuel Cocking Garden** and Observation Lighthouse 'Enoshima Sea Candle' 江の島サムエル・コッキング苑

Since the English trader Samuel Cocking built this botanical garden in the Meiji period, the garden has kept his name This white observation lighthouse 'Enoshima Sea Candle' was renovated in April 2003 after half a century, and has become a landmark on the highest point of

Enoshima Island. It is 59.8m high and at 119.6m above the







# Sightseeing Spots in Hakone & Odawara

#### Odawara Castle 小田原城

Odawara Castle is probably the best example of a castle to visit in the immediate Tokyo area. The museum in the main keep has a nice collection of artifacts, armor, and weapons. They have also done a great job reconstructing some gates and maintaining the castle grounds.

This castle was the family residence of feudal lord Hojo. You can retrace the mighty steps of feudal lords in this elegant place which has come through the Edo age to the present day.

Take a step back in time with feudal costumes - at the Tokiwagi gate of the castle, you can hire (for a fee) samurai armour and kimono and have your photograph taken wearing the outfit, with the castle in the background. It will be a wonderful souvenir of your visit.

#### Hakone Hot Springs 箱根温泉

One of Japan's foremost hot spring areas, Hakone traces its history back 1,300 years, when the first hot spring was discovered here. The area is home to some seventeen major hot springs, collectively known as the 'Hakone Ju-nana-To' each with different mineral composition and benefits. Amongst these seventeen, seven have particularly long traditions. These seven are, Yumoto, Tonosawa, Miyanoshita, Dogashima, Sokokura, Kiga, and Ashinoyu.



#### Made in Odawara: The Local Specialty Products of Odawara 小田原の特産品

Odawara, where the ocean and mountains meet in mild climate, has many local specialties. From the ocean, fish meat is ground and steamed to produce "kamaboko" (fish cake), and whole fish are sun-dried to make "himono" From the mountains, orange and lemon crops are grown, and plums are pickled to make their famous *umeboshi*. Since they have prospered as a post station and castle town from long ago. you can still see traditional techniques in thei popular souvenirs, such as "Odawara-chochin (lantern), "yosegi zaiku" (wood mosaic) and "Odawara-shikki" (lacquerware)

## Owakudani Valley

One of the most popular sightseeing spots in Hakone. This area was created during the great collapse of Kami-yama, the highest of the Hakone volcano complex about 3,000



years ago; a phreatic eruption in 2015 created a new crater. Fumarolic gases envelop the desolate ground to this day, and you can feel the intensity of an active volcano. This place is also a popular viewing point for Mt. Fuji. \*Due to the volcano activity, you might not be able to enter the area. Please check the detail at Hakone-machi website. >> www.town.hakone.kanagawa.jp There is also the "Hakone Geo Museum" in front of Owakudani Station, where you can experience the wonder and fascination of the Hakone Volcano.

## Hakone Jinja Shrine

Hakone Jinja Shrine is famous for its Shinto shrine archway of Peace, which was founded in its current location in 757 based on a revelation of the priest Mangan. Mangan was a famous priest who trained in strict ascetic practices and pacified the nine-headed dragon that lived at the bottom of Lake Ashi, and his story is still handed down to



people today. On the way to the shrine, there is a treasure house where Hakone Gongen Engi Emaki, Mangan Shonin Zazou, historical handwritings, picture scrolls and sculptures that include five items which are ranked as National Important Cultural Property are on exhibit. This shrine is also known as one of Japan's foremost spiritual places

## Hakone Check Point Exhibition Hall

Tokugawa shogun placed 53 sekisho (facility for inspection) on major roads across the nation to defend Edo (current Tokyo). Hakone Sekisho was one of the largest and was thought to be important among them. Hakone Sekisho was placed on the current location in 1619, during an


early period of Edo Era. One of the main roles of sekisho was to control 'incoming guns and outgoing women', which means to prevent weapons from being brought into Edo and wives and children of feudal lords from fleeing from Edo. However, Hakone Sekisho did not inspect 'incoming guns', and severely inspected 'outgoing women'. Sekisho, which operated for about 260 years during Edo Era, was dissolved in the next year of 1868, when the ernment changed.



#### Yosegi zaiku (Wood mozaic) 寄木細工

The mountain area of Hakone is well known for its diverse variety of trees. Artisans began making these wood works in geometric patterns bringing out the natural colors of wood at Hatajuku of Hakone Mountain in the Late Edo period. In recent years, young craftsmen to create a work of innovative design, it has been noted by many people. Because there are many shops which sell the new designs created based on traditional works in Hakone, let's stop by to look for making wood works like coasters.





There is a forest of wild birds, an open field of flowers, and a nature trail nearby: wild birds, an open field of flowers, and a nature trail nearby; Lake Ashi and Sengokuhara are also readily accessible. They use their two private hot spring sources for both the "daiyokujo" (large public bath) and "roten-buro" (outdoor bath). Due to the rarity of an onsen that is well-balanced and contains neither too many nor too few minerals, it is called "The Prescription of the Onsen Goddess". In addition, day trip bathing is available. Their spacious and comfortable private family bath is also popular!





Renoir was a successful portrait painter depicting city manners and customs, suburb leisure and females in a bright, vivid brush stroke.


### Forest Promenade of Pola Museum of Art
