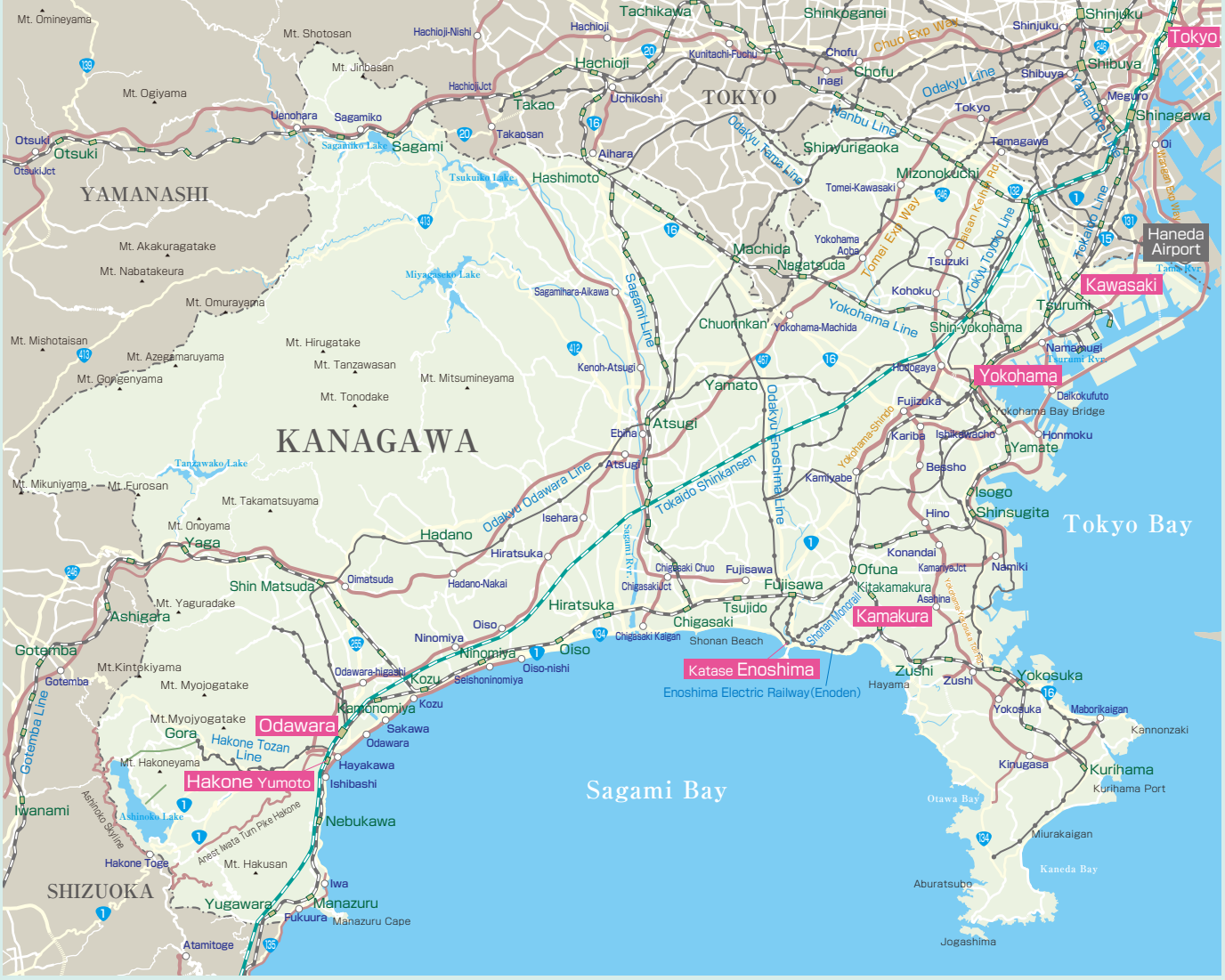

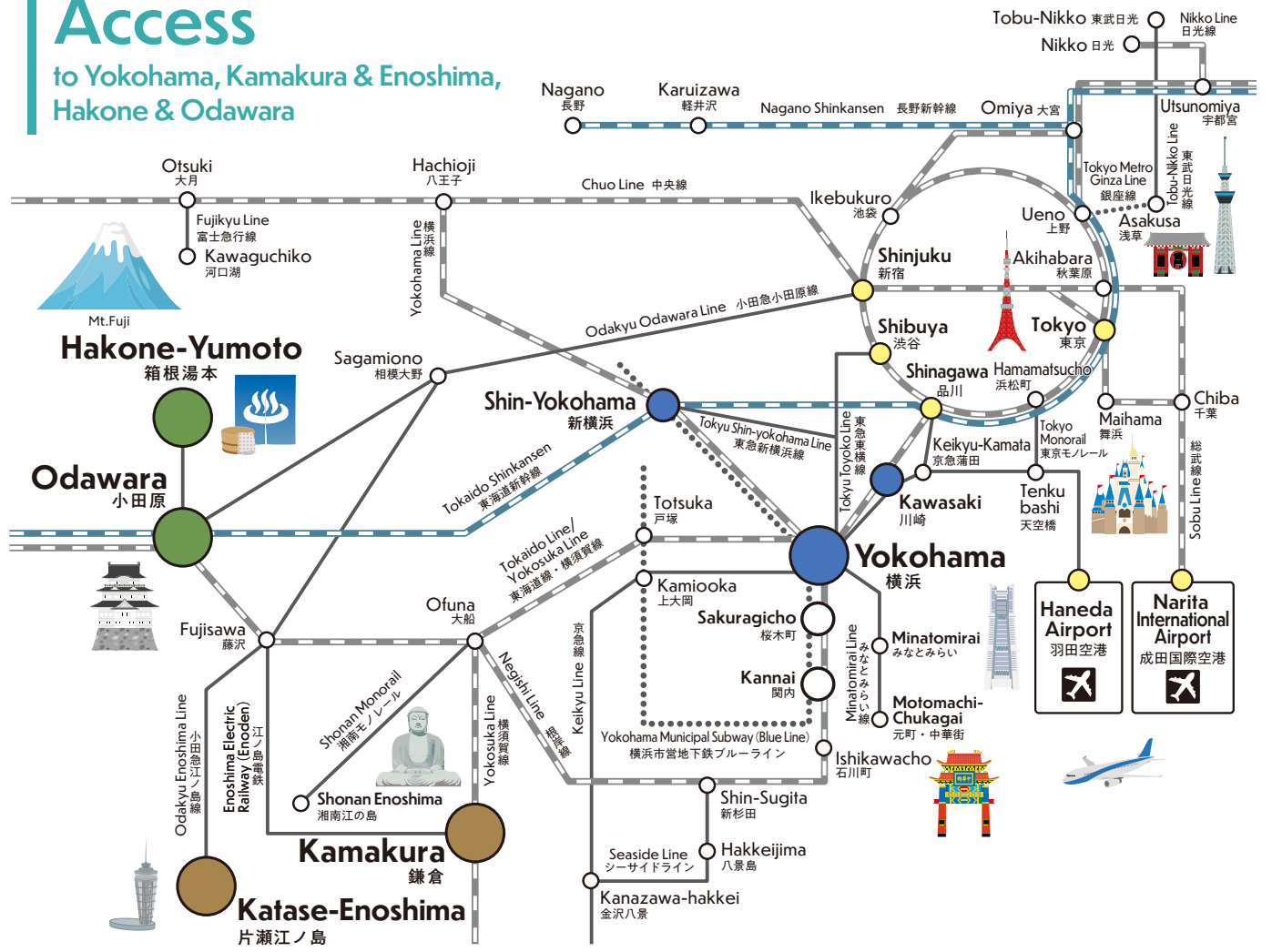

Tourism Rules and Etiquette

Follow the local rules and manners and have fun sightseeing!

Manners at restaurants and retail stores



No outside food or drinks allowed

It is generally prohibited to bring food and beverages purchased from other stores into an establishment.



At restaurants, try to clean your plate

Please enjoy the food you ordered and leave as little as possible.



Avoid touching products indiscriminately

There are some stores that sell products that you shouldn't touch because they are highly artistic or doing so would be unhygienic, among other reasons. If you are unsure whether it is okay to touch something, please check with the staff.

Manners in public places



Drinking on the street and smoking outside smoking areas are prohibited

Avoid drinking alcohol in places where there is a lot of traffic or where it may cause a nuisance. Also, smoking is only allowed in designated areas.



Be considerate when using public transportation

When using public transportation such as trains and buses, please do not make loud noises and be considerate of your surroundings. Also, please give priority seats to the physically disabled, the elderly, pregnant women, those traveling with small children, and those who are sick or injured.

Please don't leave trash in shops or public places; separate it and throw it in a public trash can or take it back to your accommodation.



How to enter a hot spring

- 1 Baths for men and women are usually separated. Check the entrance sign of the bath before entering the room.
- 2 Take your slippers off before you enter the bathroom.
- 3 Wash your body before entering the bath.
- 4 Do not put your towel in the bathtub.
- 5 No swimsuits are allowed at the baths.
- 6 Tattoos are not allowed at many baths in Japan.
- 7 Wipe your body thoroughly with your towel before you wear a yukata nightwear.



How to pay homage at shrines and temples



- 1 Put the donation into the offering box
- 2 After ringing the bell, bow twice and clap your hands twice before praying
- 3 Bow once at the end

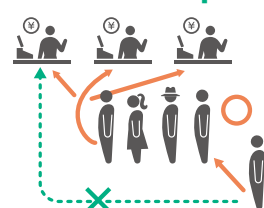


- 1 Put the donation into the offering box
- 2 If there is a gong, ring it, and pray with your palms pressed together in front of your chest, without clapping your hands
- 3 Bow once at the end



How to wait for a turn in Japan

In Japan, when there are several cashiers or toilets, there is often a case that people make a single queue to wait for their turn. The front person of a queue goes to an available cashier or a toilets.



Enjoy taking photos having good manners!

- 1 Do not enter dangerous areas like railroad crossing or driveway.
- 2 Do not stay on a sidewalk for a long time or hang around there in a group when you take photos. Otherwise, it may cause inconvenience to pedestrians.
- 3 At some places like art museums and shrines, taking photo is prohibited. Make sure that you check any notices placed there in advance.

In Kanagawa prefecture, indoor smoking is generally prohibited under the Health Promotion Act.

(Excluding designated smoking rooms, etc.)

When visiting restaurants and hotels, please check for smoking signs and follow the rules. Penalties may be imposed when rules are violated.

Do not allow people under the age of 20 to enter the smoking area.

Even if you smoke outdoors, please be careful to prevent exposure to second-hand smoke in areas frequented by children.

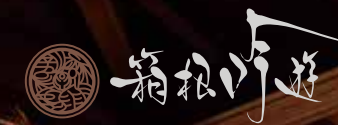

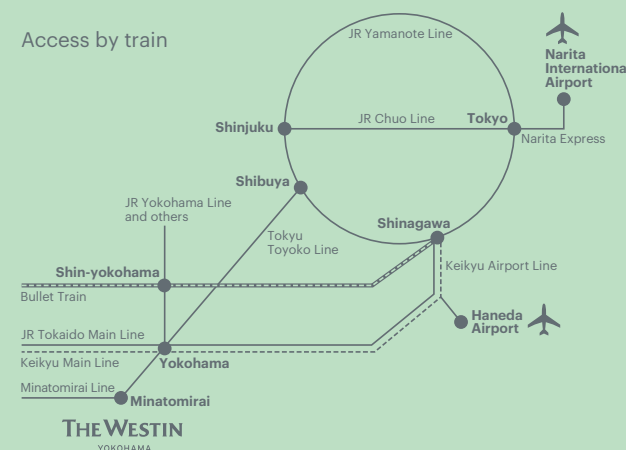

① Lake Ashi 芦ノ湖



This long, narrow lake with a circumference of 19 kilometers was formed in the caldera of the Hakone volcano approximately 3,000 years ago. It is also famous for its beautiful views, including those of the magnificent Mt. Fuji. **MAP P24 A-3 to C-5**



Hakone Sightseeing Cruise 箱根海賊船

These sightseeing ships that navigate Lake Ashi are modeled after pirate ships. Enjoy a cruise on Lake Ashi where you can savor the nature of each season. There are currently 3 types of ships in service.

Onsen & Ryokan (Japanese-style inn) 温泉と旅館

Hakone has nearly 20 hot springs. There are also many *ryokan* equipped with large public baths and open-air baths, where you can thoroughly enjoy the atmosphere of Japan.



② Hakone Shrine 箱根神社



This shrine was founded in 757 by Manganshonin, who received an oracle from Hakone-no Ookami, the god of Hakone. Today, it is famous for divine virtues such as good luck and warding off evils, and a power spot, as well as the Heiwa no Torii ("Gate of Peace") standing in Lake Ashi. On the grounds, there is also a treasure hall that stores and exhibits national important cultural properties.
