**01. Lake Ashi 芦/湖** (MAP P38 B-5) Enjoy pleasure cruise, boats, etc. at the lake! There are also a shrine, museums, and amusement spots.

**02. Owakudani Valley** 大涌谷 (MAP P38 C-3) The crater area is filled with smokes & smell of sulfur. It's also famous as a viewpoint of Mt. Fuji.

**03. Odawara Castle** 小田原城(MAP P39 G-5) Documents are exhibited in the castle building. The park is also attractive to enjoy the nature.

**04.** Kamaboko (steamed seasoned fish paste) かまぼこ Odawara's local specialties. They are made by seasoning, forming & cooking white fish.

**05. Hakone Ropeway 箱根ロープ** ウェイ(MAP P38 C-3 ~ A-3) Get close to Mt. Fuji by ropeway.

**06.** Hotsprings (Onsen) 温泉 There are various kinds and types of onsen. You can find different efficacies. 07. Ryokan (Japanese-style inn) 旅館

### **▼** Smoking Restriction Signs **▼**





Kanagawa Prefecture has set the smoking rules to prevent exposure to secondhand smoke in public spaces such as restaurants and hotels. The ordinance requires those facilities to choose whether to become nonsmoking or offer separate smoking areas.

- In Kanagawa Prefecture, indoor smoking is restricted by the ordinance which requires applicable public facilities to be nonsmoking or to offer separate smoking areas.
- At restaurants, guests are required to check those smoking restriction signs displayed and to follow the smoking rules.
- Minors under 20 years old are prohibited to enter the smoking sections/areas.

Young sardines are main local specialty. You can taste the raw sardines if you visit the area during the season!


#### 12. Zazen (Zen meditation) 座禅

### Motomachi Shopping Street 元町ショッピングストリート

A shopping street centered around streets from 1 Chome to 5 Chome. There is a symbolic arch with a phoenix-shaped sculpture at the entrances on both ends. The street is lined up with many well-established brand shops of "Hama Tra" (Yokohama Traditional Fashion), as well as other shops of clothing, variety goods, antiques, cutlery, furniture, jewelry and popular foreign brands, delicious restaurants and fashionable cafes. Benches for resting and watering holes for pets are provided, offering a friendly environment for both humans and pets. Perfect place for a casual stroll. Every year at the end of February and September, a large-scale sale known as "Charming Sale" is held for a week. Many people from all around Japan visit Motomachi for this event. Many stores are closed on Mondays.

#### Yokohama Marine Tower 横浜マリンタワー

The Yokohama Marine Tower was built and opened in celebration of the 100th anniversary of the opening of Yokohama Port. It has been a symbol of the city since its opening, witnessing the development of Yokohama Port as a lighthouse. Although it no longer serves as a lighthouse after the renewal in 2009, it continues to be an oasis for this port town. Visitors can also enjoy the view of Mt. Fuji and Tokyo Skytree. Facilities includes a cafe, a restaurant and a bar, as well as a gift shop where you can purchase souvenirs of Yokohama.

### Sail Training Ship NIPPON MARU, Yokohama Port Museum

帆船日本丸 横浜みなと博物館

The museum is themed on the history of the Yokohama port and its relationship to people's daily lives. The exhibits demonstrate the 150 years of history of the port since its opening as well as its functions and efforts. The Nihonmaru was launched in 1930 and continued its role as a navigation training ship until 1984. It is now anchored and preserved here.

### Yokohama Nigiwai-za®, Yokohama Noh Theater® 横浜にぎわい座・横浜能楽堂

Once, Yokohama was lined with entertainment halls and theaters and was a brilliant sight to behold through the year. Even now, they hold a "Noge Street Performance" every year in front of Sakuragicho station in Noge. Many people with various talents gather here from all over Japan. There are also "Yokohama Nigiwai-za", a hall where they perform public entertainment such as rakugo (traditional Japanese comic storytelling) and manzai (stand-up comedy), and "Yokohama Noh Theater", where they hold workshops and classes in addition to performing noh (traditional musical drama) and kyogen (traditional comic theater). #### Nissan Stadium 日産スタジアム

Nissan Stadium is one of Japan's largest stadiums with a capacity of 70,000 people. It is the home stadium for the Yokohama F. Marinos of the J1 Soccer League. Their comfortable seats, which have 90cm (35 inches) of seat pitch, are one of the features of the stadium. They also have a stadium tour, during which you can see the entire stadium, including rare exhibits from the 2002 FIFA World Cup. (Fee: ¥500 for adults / 60 min.) There is an all-weather swimming pool, Nissan Waterpark, below the east stands.

Hikawamaru is a cargo and passenger ship constructed in 1930. During World War II, it was used as a government impress ship and a special hospital ship for the navy. It resumed its original role as a cargo and passenger ship in 1947 and returned to the Seattle Water Route in 1953. It retired in 1960. Visitors can tour the Art Deco-style dining room, the special guest rooms and other rooms, which were renovated based on the resources of the prewar days when the ship navigated on the Seattle Water Route. The stormy history of Hikawamaru is also displayed.

### Tsurugaoka Hachimangu

One of the historic sites that represent Kamakura. The vermilion lacquer, the green of the hills, and the blue sky by the shrine pavilion are a beautiful sight seen from Wakamiya-Oji Street, which stretches all the way to the ocean.

### Hasedera Temple 長谷寺

According to legend, in 721 AD the pious monk Tokudo Shonin discovered a large camphor tree in the mountain forests near the village of Hase in the Nara region. He realized that the trunk of the tree was large enough to provide sufficient material for carving two statues of the eleven-headed Kannon. The statue he commissioned to be carved from the lower part of the truck was enshrined in Hasedera Temple near Nara; the

statue from the upper half (actually the larger of the two) was thrown into the sea with a prayer that it would reappear to save the people. Fifteen years later, in 736 on the night of June 18, it washed ashore at Nagai Beach on the Miura Peninsula not far from Kamakura, sending out rays of light as it did. The statue was then brought to Kamakura and a temple was constructed to honor it. Since time immemorial, Hasedera Temple has been known as the 4th station among the 33 holy places in the Kanto area.

### Kamakurabori 🚳 (Kamakura Carving)

Kamakurabori is a style of carved lacquerware and a specialty of Kamakura City, that is crafted by carving wood, applying black lacquer, and then applying colored lacquer such as vermilion, blue, or yellow on top. Originally used to make articles for Buddhist rituals, this artform has been passed down for over 800 years. In the Kamakurabori Museum, where about 50 classic and contemporary works of kamakurabori are displayed, a video showing the process of making kamakurabori is played continuously, and a workshop where you can try your hand at kamakurabori carving is also held. On the first floor, there is a gift shop/cafe/gallery where you can enjoy the charm of kamakurabori in the relaxing atmosphere.

The fact that it sits in bodding), it the principle image of Notokouth in least that it is is in the open air makes it unusual amongst large Buddha statues in Japan. The Great Buddha, designated as a National Treasure by the Japanese government, is about 11.3 meters tall and weighs around 121 tons. Though in size it falls short of the Great Buddha of Todai-ji Temple at Nara (an image of Rushana-butsu [Vairochana Buddha]), it essentially retains its original form; as such it is an invaluable example of Japanese historical Buddhist art. Today, 750 years after its construction, vast numbers of Buddhists of all sects from around the world and Japan come to pay their respects to the Great Buddha.

This Zen Buddhist temple is the head temple of the Kencho sect of the Rinzai school. It was founded in the year 1253 by Tokiyori Hojo. The temple is dedicated to the bodhisattya Jizo (Kshitigarbha). The grounds are designated as a national historic site under the name "Kenchoji Keidai". With cherry blossoms, hydrangea, autumn leaves, and so on, the natural colors of each season here are charming. In addition, it is connected to the Tenen hiking course from the priests' temple quarters in the inner part of the site

### Odawara Castle

Odawara Castle is probably the best example of a castle to visit in the immediate Tokyo area. The museum in the main keep has a nice collection of artifacts, armor, and weapons. They have also done a great job reconstructing some gates and maintaining the castle grounds.

This castle was the family residence of feudal lord Hojo. You can retrace the mighty steps of feudal lords in this elegant place which has come through the Edo age to the present day.

The area is home to some seventeen major hot springs, collectively known as the 'Hakone Ju-nana-To', each with different mineral composition and benefits. Amongst these seventeen, seven have particularly long traditions. These seven are, Yumoto, Tonosawa, Miyanoshita, Dogashima, Sokokura, Kiga, and Ashinoyu.

### Made in Odawara: The Local Specialty Products of Odawara 小田原の特産品

Odawara, where the ocean and mountains meet in mild climate, has many local specialties. From the ocean, fish meat is ground and steamed to produce "kamaboko" (fish cake), and whole fish are sun-dried to make "himono". From the mountains, orange and lemon crops are grown, and plums are pickled to make their famous umeboshi. Since they have prospered as a post station and castle town from long ago, you can still see traditional techniques in their popular souvenirs, such as "Odawara-chochin" (lantern), "yosegi zaiku" (wood mosaic) and "Odawara-shikki" (lacquerware).

### Owakudani Valley

One of the most popular sightseeing spots in Hakone. This area was created during the great collapse of Kami-yama, the highest of the Hakone volcano complex about 3,000



years ago; a phreatic eruption in 2015 created a new crater. Fumarolic gases envelop the desolate ground to this day, and you can feel the intensity of an active volcano. This place is also a popular viewing point for Mt. Fuji. \*Due to the volcano activity, you might not be able to enter the area. #### Hakone Jinja Shrine 箱根神社

Hakone Jinja Shrine is famous for its Shinto shrine archway of Peace, which was founded in its current location in 757 based on a revelation of the priest Mangan. Mangan was a famous priest who trained in strict ascetic practices and pacified the nine-headed dragon that lived at the bottom of Lake Ashi, and his story is still



handed down to people today. On the way to the shrine, there is a treasure house where Hakone Gongen Engi Emaki, Mangan Shonin Zazou, historical handwritings, picture scroll and sculptures that include five items which are ranked as National Important Cultural Property are on exhibit. This shrine is also known as one of Japan's foremost spiritual places.

#### Hakone Check Point Exhibition Hall 箱根関所

Tokugawa shogun placed 53 sekisho (facility for inspection) on major roads across the nation to defend Edo (current Tokyo). Hakone Sekisho was one of the largest and was thought to be important among them. Hakone Sekisho was placed on the current location in 1619, during an

early period of Edo Era. One of the main roles of sekisho was to control 'incoming guns and outgoing women', which means to prevent weapons from being brought into Edo and wives and children of feudal lords from fleeing from Edo. However, Hakone Sekisho did not inspect 'incoming guns', and severely inspected 'outgoing women'. Sekisho, which operated for about 260 years during Edo Era, was dissolved in the next year of 1868, when the government changed.

#### Yosegi zaiku (Wood mozaic) 岑太細工

The mountain area of Hakone is well known for its diverse variety of trees. Artisans began making these wood works in geometric patterns bringing out the natural colors of wood at Hatajuku of Hakone Mountain in the Late Edo period. In recent years, young craftsmen to create a work of innovative design, it has been noted by many people.
